



Para red rocket

Para red rocket is day or night long range distress signal. It is designed to withstand exceptional environmental exposure and to perform reliably even after immersion in the water. The pull wire ignitor and improved grip provides easy handling. It ejects a red flare on a parachute at 300m (1000ft) and burns for 40 seconds at 30,000 candela.
